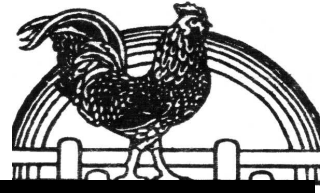

NEIGHBOURHOOD STALL REGULATIONS

1. The purpose of the Society is to encourage, support, and provide an outlet for local produce.
 - A. Only fresh fruits and vegetables, cut and dried flowers, and fresh and dried herbs may be sold in Neighbourhood stalls.
 - B. Vendors must produce 100% of the crops which they sell.
 - C. All crops for sale must be grown in the Kamloops region.
2. The rental of a stall space remains the right of the Kamloops Regional Farmers' Market Society. The Society also may limit or control activities at the Market, including vending, entertainment, and promotions.
 - A. Each year, vendors must complete an application form and submit it to the board of executives. A contract must be signed with the Market Society.
 - B. Stall rental fee of \$5.00 will be paid to the Market manager before or during individual markets, as determined by the Market manager.
3. All vendors must comply with fire, health, and safety regulations of the City of Kamloops and the Province of British Columbia.
 - A. If scales are used, they must be certified legal for trade. We encourage you to sell by the bag, box, or item, rather than by weight.
 - B. Vendors are responsible for the accuracy of all verbal and written messages in their stalls. You must not say your apples are "tree-ripened" unless this is true. If you sign says "no pesticides," make certain this is actually the case.
 - C. All animals brought to Market must be on a leash (or caged), and under their owners' control at all times.

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4. Securing of canopies, umbrellas, coolers, etc. is the responsibility of individual vendors. Liability for any damage or injury caused by insecure fixtures is not covered by the Farmers' Market insurance policy.
5. Vendors are solely responsible for cleaning their sites at the end of each day.
6. For safety reasons, only emergency vehicles can be driven in the Market space during Market hours. A Neighbourhood stall vendor who wishes to unload produce in the Market space must arrive early (by 7:30AM if possible), quickly unload onto the sidewalk, then remove the vehicle from the Market before setting up a vending stall.
7. The Kamloops Regional Farmers' Market Society board of directors and its Market managers has the right to evict and/or bar anyone, temporarily or permanently, who fails to comply with its regulations.
8. All complaints must be sent, in writing, to the Kamloops Farmers' Market Society board of directors.
